Tips for renting your home:

- 1. Make sure to have the boiler serviced before the new tenant moves in. It is important that this is done by a registered gas installer and that they leave a sticker on the boiler informing the tenant when the next service is due.
- 2. Install a carbon monoxide alarm in the property.
- 3. Leave a fire blanket & small fire extinguisher in the kitchen.
- 4. If there is a fireplace in the property make sure that the chimney is swept and it is possible to light a fire.
- 5. Clean all carpets and remove any stains from floor coverings or walls.
- 6. Ensure that mattresses are new failing this make sure there is a new mattress protector.
- 7. Make sure all bath and shower seals are intact.
- 8. Ensure that all utilities are fully functional.
- 9. Leave clear written instructions on how to use the heating and water heater.
- 10. If the property is in an apartment complex provide details of the management company and working fobs for security gates.
